Let Guardian Become Part of Your Home

Guardian works best when it becomes a consistent part of your home. For the best long-term experience:

Every day, simply

- ✓ Keep Guardian connected to power.
- ✓ Keep it connected to your network whenever possible.
- ✓ Leave it in a consistent location.
- ✓ Allow air to move freely around the device.

Why it helps

Small habits today help create more meaningful environmental trends tomorrow.

Keep the Air Moving

Guardian continuously draws air into the bottom of the device, where it passes through the sensor capsules before exiting through the top.



Air enters the bottom, passes through the sensor capsules, and exits the top. Keeping the intake and outlet clear keeps your readings accurate.

To maintain accurate readings

- ✓ Keep both the air intake and air outlet unobstructed.
- ✓ Avoid placing decorations, books, furniture, or other objects directly against the device.
- ✓ Give Guardian open space so air can circulate naturally.

Keep it clear

Restricted airflow can affect measurement accuracy.

Cleaning Your Guardian

Guardian doesn't require special cleaning products or routine maintenance. When it's time to freshen it up, four gentle steps are all it takes.

1

Disconnect power

Unplug your Guardian before you begin cleaning.

2

Wipe the exterior

Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the outside of the device.

3

Clear the vents

Ensure the air intake and outlet remain free of dust or debris.

4

Reconnect power

Plug your Guardian back in once cleaning is complete.

Please avoid

- ✗ Spraying cleaners directly onto the device.
- ✗ Allowing moisture to enter any openings.
- ✗ Blocking the air intake or air outlet.
- ✗ Disassembling the Guardian beyond normal installation procedures.

Caring for Your Sensor Capsules

Guardian uses modular sensor capsules that are designed to be replaceable. During installation or replacement, two quick checks keep everything working smoothly.

When installing a capsule

- ✓ Confirm each sensor capsule is fully seated.
- ✓ Press gently until you hear an audible click.

Checking sensor health

Guardian also makes it easy to monitor the health of its capsules. Within the device settings, you can view the health status of each installed sensor.

SENSOR HEALTH

All sensors healthy

Particulate Sensor		100%
Gas / VOC Sensor		100%
CO2 Sensor		98%

New capsules show 100%. A lower value means it may be time to consider service or replacement.

A feature worth knowing

New sensor capsules display 100% health, while worn or malfunctioning sensors show a lower value — helping you determine when replacement may be needed.

Moving Your Guardian

If you relocate Guardian to another room or another property, it's a good idea to establish a new baseline for the new environment.

Start a fresh baseline

Guardian includes built-in options for restarting the VOC and CO2 baselines when moving to a new location after it has been in use. This helps ensure the most accurate data is collected for the new environment.
